He met the love of his life Ann Smith at "The Plaza Dance Hall". They were married April 21, 1945 and again May 26, 1945. On their 60th wedding anniversary they renewed their wedding vows.

Through out his life he had many occupations. He was a dairyman, farmer, baker and ditch tender. Most importantly, he was a volunteer fireman for over 50 years in Goshen and serving as fire chief during some of those years. He founded the Tulare County Sheriff's Aero Squadron Search & Rescue with Sol Sweet. He was also known as the most famous bartender at the PPAV Hall.

He is survived by his daughters, Linda Perry, Cheryl Faria (Dan), Karen Avila, Diane Rader (Bobby), Kathleen Soria (Ephraim), and son-in-law Kelly Black. His loving sister, Hilda Ennes, brother-in-law, Lewis Smith, 15 grandchildren, 27 great grandchildren and 12 great great grandchildren.
