Steven Kabot, 72, died at home July 23, 2018. Born in Newark, New Jersey, he was the son of Nathan and Ruth Rader Kabot.

Steven was a devoted husband and father, known for his quick wit and the twinkle in his eye. He earned his undergraduate degree from Lehigh University and his law degree from Georgetown University in 1970. He met his love Florence on a blind date, and soon after they were married. After spending a year as an AmeriCorps VISTA member in Baltimore, they drove west to begin their lives in California. Their daughter Sara was born in 1980, the same year he went into private practice with McCormick, Ide, and Kabot practicing primarily municipal law. Steven was civic minded and a man of integrity. After retiring in 2016, he still aspired to make this world a better place and dedicated himself to his community, serving as Board President for Family Health Care Network.
